## Understanding and Changing Challenging Behaviors in People with Developmental Disabilities

Dr. Thomas Mates

May 6, 2010

Dr. Mates will focus his presentation on what factors contribute to a person's behavior. He will identify different communication/behavioral diagnoses and how these diagnoses impact social understanding, communication, and relationships. The participants of this workshop will develop a better understanding of the sources of challenging behaviors and learn effective strategies that will help to decrease these behaviors. Dr. Mates' discussion will include information about individuals with intellectual disability, Autism Spectrum Disorders, anxiety, Bi-polar, Attention Deficit Disorder and Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder.

Dr. Tom Mates is a clinical psychologist with an extensive background that includes working with youth with developmental disabilities involved in the court system. He provides treatment for and training on individuals with developmental disabilities and autism who have co-existing mental health issues.
